A RESOLUTION

Regarding acceptance of gifts and donations in accordance with Chapter 575 to the Government Code concerning acceptance of gifts and donations by certain state agencies; Docket No. 2002-1275-MIS

WHEREAS, the Seventy-fifth Legislature passed Senate Bill 145, which added Chapter 575 to the Government Code concerning acceptance of gifts and donations by certain state agencies. The Seventy-sixth Legislature passed Senate Bill 183, which amended Section 575.003 of the Government Code. Sections 575.002 and 575.003 of Chapter 575 provide that a majority of the Commission must acknowledge the acceptance of all gifts of money or property with a value of \$500.00 or more in an open meeting no later than the 90th day after the date the gift is accepted.

WHEREAS, a list of gifts and donations submitted for acknowledgment is attached as Exhibit "A." The gifts have been accepted by the Executive Director. The list includes a description and amount of each gift or donation with a value of \$500.00 or more, the donor's name, and a statement regarding the purpose of each gift or donation in accordance with Section 575.004 of Chapter 575.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY that the Commission acknowledges acceptance of the gifts and donations listed in Exhibit "A" in accordance with Chapter 575 of the Government Code.
